- 4. Your address, telephone number, and email address so that we may contact you;
- 5. A statement by you that you have a good faith belief that the disputed use of the copyrighted work is not authorized by the copyright owner and is not otherwise permitted by law;
- 6. As statement by you, made under penalty of perjury, that the infringement notice is accurate and that you are the copyright owner or authorized to act on the copyright owner's behalf;
- 7. An electronic or physical signature of the copyright owner.
